104c: PY + X MEDIUM (N2/CO2)

This recipe contains strain-specific modifications for Clostridium felsineum DSM 7320 *

Final pH: * 6.3

Final volume: 1000 ml

Trypticase peptone (BD BBL)	5.00	g
Meat peptone (pepsin-digested)	5.00	g
Yeast extract	10.00	g
Salt solution	40.00	ml
Sodium resazurin (0.1% w/v)	0.50	ml
L-Cysteine HCl x H ₂ O	0.50	g
Na ₂ CO ₃	1.00	g
D-Glucose	5.00	g
Distilled water	960.00	ml

Dissolve ingredients (except cysteine, carbonate and glucose) and sparge medium with $80\%~N_2$ and $20\%~CO_2$ gas mixture for 30 - 45 min to make it anoxic. Add cysteine, then dispense under $80\%~N_2$ and $20\%~CO_2$ gas atmosphere into anoxic Hungate-type tubes or serum vials and autoclave. Add glucose from a sterile anoxic stock solution prepared under $100\%~N_2$ gas atmosphere and carbonate from a sterile anoxic stock solution prepared under $80\%~N_2$ and $20\%~CO_2$ gas atmosphere. Adjust pH of complete medium to 7.0, if necessary.
